- [E] ELECTION OR BEING CHOSEN BY GOD THE FATHER FOR SALVATION (Acts 13:48)
- [F] JUSTIFICATION OR BEING DECLARED RIGHTEOUS IN GOD'S SIGHT (Romans 3:28, 31)
- [G] PERSEVERANCE OR CONTINUING IN FAITH (John 10:25-30)
- [H] REGENERATION OR BEING BORN AGAIN BY THE HOLY SPIRIT (John 3:3-8; 6:44; 6:63-65)
- [I] HEARING THE GOSPEL (1 Peter 1:23-25; 1 Corinthians 15:1-8)
- [J] ADOPTION OR BECOMING A CHILD IN GOD'S FAMILY (Galatians 3:26)

Ephesians 1:4-5 For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. In love he predestined us to be adopted as his sons through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will—

Romans 8:28-30 And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. And those he predestined, he also called; those he called, he also justified; those he justified, he also glorified.

John 10:26 “You do not believe because you are not my sheep.” (Acts 18:27)

John 3:3 In reply Jesus declared, “I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again.”

Ephesians 2:4-5 But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions — it is by grace you have been saved.

John 1:12-13 Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God— children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God.

Acts 16:14b The Lord opened her heart to respond to Paul's message. (Romans 3:10)

Romans 10:17 Faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word of Christ.

Romans 5:1 Since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

John 5:27-29 “And he has given him authority to judge because he is the Son of Man.
